- ❖ **New immunization requirements for the 2017-2018 school year are now in place. All 9th and 10th grade students must have an updated Tdap and Meningococcal Vaccine.** This includes those **10th grade students that are retained.** Please follow up with your student's health care provider to make sure that they are compliant. Those students not in compliance will be notified prior to the start of the school year and **will not be allowed to attend classes on day one of school** unless proof that vaccines were completed or proof of appointment brought in to the school nurse.

BUS DRIVER RECRUITING FAIR

There will be a Bus Driver Recruiting Fair on June 14th from 1-7 p.m. at the Career and Technology Academy in Prince Frederick (behind Calvert High School).

School bus drivers work for independent bus contractors throughout Calvert County. These contractors hire drivers to drive daily routes, to drive as substitutes, and to drive trips to athletic and extracurricular events. The contractors who serve Calvert County Public Schools are seeking qualified candidates to be trained and certified as school bus drivers. This is a great opportunity to work close to home and to serve the children and schools in our community.

ATHLETIC INFORMATION

To try out for any sport during the school year students must have the following forms on file: a current Physical Evaluation Form (with a year), Insurance Waiver Form, and Parent Consent Form. These can be printed from the CCPS website or the Northern High School website under athletics: www.calvertnet.k12.md.us.

Athletic Schedules: Seasonal Athletic Schedules are available on the SMAC website: www.smacathletics.org. These schedules are subject to change due to weather and other conflicts. Mark your calendars now, **Fall Sports Tryouts start on August 9th**.

Reminder - make sure you get your physicals in before the fall sport season starts. Preferably by the end of July so paperwork can be updated. Athletes will not be able to tryout unless a current physical is on file.

Electronic Submission of Physicals: You can now submit your sports physicals electronically through the following link: www.calvertcounty-ar.schooltoday.com. Create an account and you can upload and send your sports physical forms electronically! Please make sure you include the insurance waiver and the parent consent form.
